## New year flower square

## The story behind the pattern.

I crocheted this square on New Year's Eve 2020. I think it looks a little bit like firework in the middle of the square or maybe it's a flower as usual :). I hope you like the pattern!

## Introduction

First you crochet the flower (round 1-8). Next step is to make the flower into a square (round 9-12). The stitches in the pictures are the stitches I crocheted (not what they count as).

## Symbols

*...* Repeat stitches
**...** Repeat stitches within repetition
<...》 Crocheted in the same or given stitch

## Alternatives

The pattern below can be adjusted, depending on your own preferences. For example:

- The initial ch on round 1 can be made with a magic ring.
- You can start each round with a standing stitch wherever possible, instead of ch.
- You can end each round with an invisible join wherever possible, instead of a sl st.

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## The flower (round 1-8)

## R. 1

Ch 4 (counts as ch 1, 1dc), 11 dc in the first ch. Tighten the ring by pulling the short yarn thread. Finish with 1 sl st in the first dc (the beginning chain). Do not cut the yarn. (Total $1 \mathrm{ch}, 12 \mathrm{dc}$ ).

## R. 2

Ch 7 (counts as $1 \mathrm{sc}, \operatorname{ch} 6$ ) *skip $1 d c, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $d c$, $\operatorname{ch} 6$ * 5 times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first sc (the first ch on the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $36 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$ )


## R. 3

Change color. Start the round in a free dc on r. 1 between 2 sc and behind ch-6 sp. *<3 dc (ch 3, $2 d c$ in first repetition) > in $d c r .1$ behind ch- 6 sp , ch 3 , skip $1 \mathrm{sc} * 6$ times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first dc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $18 \mathrm{ch}, 18 \mathrm{dc}$ )

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## R. 5

Change color. Start the round between sc and first dc of five. *《3dc (ch 3, $2 d c$ in first repetition) > between sc and first dc of five, ch 1, skip $2 d c$, 1 sc in next dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, $\ll 3 d c »$ between fifth $d c$ of five and sc* 6 times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first dc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $12 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{sc}, 36 \mathrm{dc}$ )

## R. 6

Change color. Start the round in ch-1 sp before sc. *<3 dc (ch 3, $2 d c$ in first repetition)» in ch-1 sp before sc, skip 1 sc, «3 dc>> in next ch-1 sp, 3 BPdc, 1 FPdc around sc r.4, 3 BPdc* 6 times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first dc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $36 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{FPdc}, 36 \mathrm{BPdc}$ )

## R. 7

Change color. Start the round in the first BPdc of three before FPdc.
*2 sc (ch 1, 1 sc in first repetition), skip 1 BPdc, 1 FPhdc around FPdc on r.6, skip 1 BPdc, 2 sc, 6 BPhdc* 6 times. Finish with 1 sl st in first sc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn.
(Total $24 \mathrm{sc}, 36$ BPhdc, 6 FPhdc)

## R. 8

Change color. Start the round in sc after 6 BPhdc. *2 sc (ch 1, 1 sc in first repetition), 1 FPhdc around FPhdcr. $7,2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 h d c, \ll 1 h d c, 1 d c \gg, \ll 1 d c, 1 h d c \gg, 2 h d c * 6$ times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first sc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn.
(Total $24 \mathrm{sc}, 6$ FPhdc, $36 \mathrm{hdc}, 12 \mathrm{dc}$ )

## The square (round 9-13)

## R. 9

Change color. Start the round in sc after 1 FPhdc. *《2 $\operatorname{tr}$ (ch 4, 1 tr in first repetition) > in sc after 1 FP hdc, $1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, \ll 2 \mathrm{tr} \gg \mathrm{in}$ FP $\mathrm{hdc}, 1$ FPtr around FPhdc r. 8 (the same FPhdc as you crocheted 2 tr in before) * 6 times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first tr (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $18 \mathrm{sc}, 12 \mathrm{hdc}, 24 \mathrm{dc}, 36 \mathrm{tr}, 6$ FPtr)

## R. 10

Change color. Start the round in FPtr. *3 sc (ch 1, 2 sc in first repetition), 11 hdc, 2 sc* 6 times. Finish with 1 sl st in first sc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $30 \mathrm{sc}, 66 \mathrm{hdc}$ )

## R. 11

Change color. Start the round in third sc of five. *1 sc (ch 1 in first repetition), $3 \mathrm{hdc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ $\operatorname{tr}, \ll 2 \operatorname{tr} \gg,<2 \operatorname{tr} \gg, c h 1,<2 \operatorname{tr} \gg,<2 \operatorname{tr}>, 2 \mathrm{tr}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{sc} * 4$ times. Finish with 1 sl st in first sc (the beginning chain). Do not cut yarn. (Total $8 \mathrm{sc}, 24 \mathrm{hdc}, 32 \mathrm{dc}, 48 \mathrm{tr}, 4 \mathrm{ch}$ )

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## R. 12

Change color. Start the round in a corner. * $<2 \operatorname{tr}(\operatorname{ch} 4,1$ tr in first repetition), ch 3, 2 tr>> in ch-1 sp, $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ hdc, $8 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{hdc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{tr} * 4$ times. Finish with 1 sl st in the first tr (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn.
(Total $12 \mathrm{ch}, 32 \mathrm{sc}, 40 \mathrm{hdc}, 24 \mathrm{dc}, 32 \mathrm{tr}$ )

## R. 13

1 sl st to ch-3 sp (the corner), * <<1 sc (ch 1 in first repetition), ch 3,1 sc>> in ch-3 sp, 32 sc* 4 times.
Finish with 1 sl st in first sc (the beginning chain). Cut the yarn. (Total $12 \mathrm{ch}, 136 \mathrm{sc}$ )
